South Suburban Hosts 33rd Annual High Line Canal Run in deKoevend Park

South Suburban will host its 33rd annual High Line Canal Run presented by Tokyo Joes, and sponsored by the City of Centennial, on Sat., May 10 in deKoevend Park. The event features a 10K at 8 am and a 5K Run/Walk at 9 am.

Walk or run along the scenic and relatively flat High Line Canal Trail. Children and friendly dogs welcome. Registration includes a pancake breakfast, a long sleeve race shirt, goody bag and prize drawings. Awards will be given to top male and female finishers in both the 10K and 5K race.

Walk across the bridge on the south side of the recreation center to the park. Free parking also is available at South Suburban Ice Arena, 6580 S. Vine St., Centennial.
