Be Cool: Share the Path – Free Trail Safety Awareness Event

Be Cool: Share the Path, is a free trail safety event on Sat., June 22, from 8 – 11am along the popular Mary Carter Greenway Trail in Littleton. Ride your bike, jog, walk or roll to this fun event for the entire family.

A bike rodeo, tricycle races, live music, giveaways and refreshments are planned for three locations along the Trail: Confluence of Big Dry Creek Trail and Mary Carter Greenway Trails; Reynolds Landing, located between Denver Seminary and Aspen Grove Shopping Center, and Carson Nature Center parking lot at South Platte Park. The event is presented by South Suburban Park and Recreation District and the City of Littleton and kicks off a trail safety awareness campaign. The location was purposely chosen, as the Mary Carter Greenway is the most highly used trail in the District, and is popular among commuters, bike and running enthusiasts as well as walkers and their dogs.

Local consulting firm Alta was hired to assess the Mary Carter Greenway trail for safety issues. Alta conducted stakeholder meetings and a [Report](#) of those findings can be found on the websites of South Suburban and the City of Littleton.

Entertainment will include the Yellow Dog Blues Band, and South Suburban's *Living Well Van* will offer free activities for kids. Giveaways will include dog treats and leashes, bike bells and other accessories geared to trail safety.
