**South Suburban Parks and Recreation Hires National Executive Search Firm

Lorenz was promoted from Deputy Director to the helm of the organization. Thirty years later, Lorenz is retiring after nearly 48 years with the District.

The Board of Director's mission is to seek and attract the very best candidates to lead South Suburban into the future.
